What are we doing?

Cleaning and Hygiene

- We have developed COVID-19 cleaning checklists for our venues, which includes additional cleaning and sanitisation practices
- Our teams are operating to a heightened hygiene policy

Physical Distancing

- All staff and guests are given physical distancing guidance
- We are actively minimising the number of people in shared spaces inline with government recommendations

Information and Supervision

- We have introduced training specific to COVID-19. This is compulsory for all team members prior to returning to work
- We are working with our teams to ensure they are aware of their responsibilities
- Signage is in place to advise guests and staff of the safe protocols for managing risks associated with COVID-19

Record Keeping

 All bookings required the name and contact phone number of the guest responsible for each booking

Managing Risks

- We are implementing strategies to mitigating the risk of entry or spread of the disease in our venues. We are operating to a new set of standards and we ask you to join us in maintaining a high degree of responsibility
